New Structures

- Temporary dock
 - A temporary dock has been installed across the far side of the Bowl to allow athletes to move from one side to the other more expeditiously, especially athletes who compete in events on both the sawing/chopping dock and the boom run/logrolling dock. This temporary dock is accessed only through the athlete areas and is not available for public or spectating use.
- Production Building
 - There is a new production building located on the center, back, of the Main bleacher area. This area will allow the show director, announcer, and timing crew to work more efficiently together and with the space required to complete their tasks during the LWC competition. Louisiana Pacific is the property sponsor of the new production building.
